Opinion

Basis for Opinion

We did not audit the financial statements, financial information of the Associate included in the consolidated financial results, whose financial statements and financial information reflect total assets of Rs. 14382.98 Lakhs as at March 31, 2023, total revenues of Rs. 1534.27 Lakhs for the year ended March 31, 2023, total net profit after tax of Rs. 441.60 Lakhs for the year ended March 31, 2023, total comprehensive income of Rs. 416.17 Lakhs for the year ended March 31, 2023, and net cash outflow of Rs. 1015.19 Lakhs for the year ended March 31, 2023, as considered in the Statement. These financial results have been audited by other auditor whose report have been furnished to us and our opinion on the financial result, in so far as it relates to the amounts and the disclosures included in respect of this associate, is based solely on the report of the other auditor and the audit procedures performed by us.

Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of this matter.
